**Statements Required:

- a. **Breeding age females**
 - i. “Virgin heifer(s)” OR
 - ii. “Cow(s) or heifer(s) are confirmed pregnant OR
 - iii. “Not confirmed pregnant and must be held in a dry lot for feeding and direct to slaughter only.”
 - iv. “Cow with calf at side has not been exposed to bull since calving”
- b. **Bulls of all ages:**
 - i. “Virgin bull(s) <24 months of age and has(have) had no potential breeding contact with females.” OR
 - ii. “The bull(s) tested negative on Trichomoniasis PCR test within 60 days prior to entry with no female contact since qualifying test.”
OR
 - iii. “The bull(s) have had three consecutive negative Trichomonas foetus culture tests which were at least a week apart with no female contact since qualifying tests.”
- c. **Feeder Heifers**
 - i. “For feeding purposes only”

***Females ≥12 months must be Official Calfhod Vaccinates for Brucellosis (OCV) *

1. Statement on health certificate that the shield tattoo is visible.
2. Non-calfhood vaccinates for brucellosis will require a “Waiver of Calfhod Vaccination”. SFN 60303(link on our page doesn’t work)
