Testing Requirements and Statements**

Trichomoniasis-all non virgin bulls and
all bulls over 24 months of age
HPAI milk test for all lactating cows

- **North Dakota recognizes the designated surveillance area of Greater Yellowstone for Brucellosis. Brucellosis test date must be provided if animals are coming from Montana's, Idaho's, or Wyoming's DSA zone.**

*ND origin cattle sold at an auction market inspected by ND Brand officials may return to ND without ID within 72 hours of sale, if the origin owner and complete address are documented on the CVI.

****Statements Required:**

a. **Breeding age females**

- i. "Virgin heifer(s)" OR
- ii. "Cow(s) or heifer(s) are confirmed pregnant OR
- iii. "Not confirmed pregnant and must be held in a dry lot for feeding and direct to slaughter only."
- iv. "Cow with calf at side has not been exposed to bull since calving"

b. **Bulls of all ages:**

- i. "Virgin bull(s) <24 months of age and has(have) had no potential breeding contact with females." OR
- ii. "The bull(s) tested negative on Trichomoniasis PCR test within 60 days prior to entry with no female contact since qualifying test."
OR
- iii. "The bull(s) have had three consecutive negative Trichomonas foetus culture tests which were at least a week apart with no female contact since qualifying tests."
