



# North Dakota Department of Agriculture Importation Requirements Dairy Cattle

## CANADA

Health Certificate (CVI)	Importation Permit	Official Identification
Issued within 30 days of entry	Required for all cattle Import Permit #: (701) 328-2655	All dairy cattle (RFID or CFIA tag) All cattle must have the CAN ear tattoo or the CAN brand on high right hip

### Testing Requirements and Statements

#### Brucellosis Test

Females > 12 months of age must be Official Calhhood Vaccinates or require a waiver of calhhood vaccination by the importer along with a negative brucellosis test within 30 days prior to importation.

All other cattle >18 months of age must have a negative Brucellosis test within 30 days of Importation.

#### TB Test

All cattle > than 60 days of age and within 60 days of importation (nursing calves exempt)

#### Trichomoniasis

All non-virgin bulls and all bulls over 24 months of age

\*\*Non-virgin, non-pregnant female cattle are not eligible for importation into North Dakota for breeding purposes unless they qualify for the exemptions outlined in: <https://ndlegis.gov/information/acdata/pdf/48.1-05-01.pdf>
